




Arizona General Fund Spending Then and now (dollars per capita)




Arizona General Fund Spending Then and now (dollars per capita)



Arizona General Fund Spending Then and now (% change in per capita 1990 to 2017)




Arizona Highway Users Revenue Fund (HURF) Then and now (dollars per capita)











The Rise of the Electric Vehicle Battery Prices are Falling Faster





The Rise of the Electric Vehicle Price Parity is Coming


Projected Price Parity Point for 200-Mile Range EV Inclusive of Five Year Total Cost of Ownership



The Rise of the Electric Vehicle Increasing Range






The Rise of the Electric Vehicle Consumers' Response
