On Dec. 2, the Gallagher & Kennedy personal injury and wrongful death practice group came together as a team to pack meals for Feed My Starving Children (FMSC), a non-profit organization committed to feeding malnourished children in nearly 70 countries around the world.

The team packed 50 boxes of food and in addition to their time, they donated \$1,200 to further the mission of FMSC. With each

box containing 432 meals and production costs of just 22 cents per FMSC meal, their total donation equates to a total of 27,100 meals for hungry or starving children in developing countries. One box of food will feed a child for seven months. FMSC relies on the support of volunteers, as each meal is hand-packed and 100 percent donor funded.

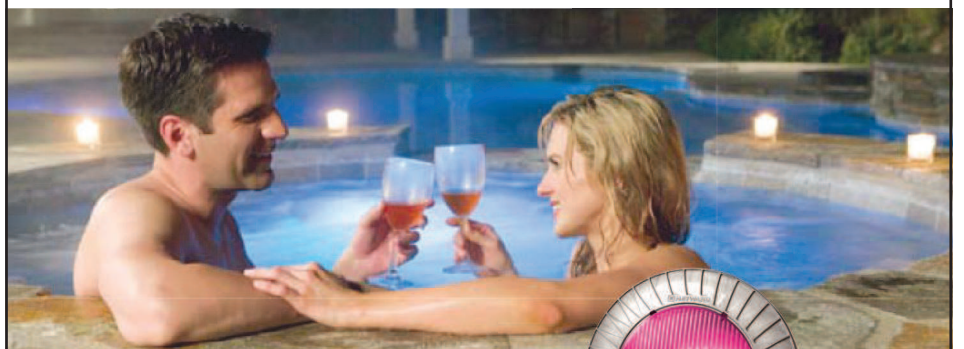
